If needed, callbacks will be held on Friday, January 31st, from 7 to 9:30 p.m. and/or Sunday, February 2nd, from 1 to 5 p.m., either via Zoom or in person in Sterling, VA.

All roles are open to any race or ethnicity. The age range and gender of the character portrayed are listed. Please see the detailed character descriptions for more information. Some roles may be doubled.

When Clara Rutherford is hired to mold nouveau riche bachelor Eli Boyd into a true gentleman, spats ensue and sparks fly. But will the elite Four Hundred ever accept him, or will all of the chaos she's stirred up in his household - and his heart - be for naught?

Note: Memorization of audition materials is not required or expected.

Required audition materials for singing roles:

A short monologue selected from the list <u>here</u>.

A scene from the show selected from the list here (for actors aged 16+ only).

A 16-32 bar cut from a song from the show (see below).

Required audition materials for non-singing roles:

A short monologue selected from the <u>list</u>.

A scene from the show selected from the <u>list</u> (for actors aged 16+ only).

Optional additional audition materials:

One or two additional monologues from the <u>list</u>.

One or two additional <u>scenes</u> from the show (actors aged 16+ only)

Another 16-32 bar cut from the show (see below)

For the scene recordings, feel free to record the scene with a reader - either on or off camera - or just leave a pause where the other lines would be. Either is fine.

Please note: Optional materials are truly optional. We want to offer more choices (to show range, additional characterization, interest in several roles, etc...), but if the required materials alone show you at your best, that's perfectly fine.

To submit your audition, please email either a link to the video(s) uploaded as "unlisted" on YouTube OR attach the video(s) to an email, whichever you prefer. (For more information about video submission, please see our FAQ.)

For each song, there is a link for both a midi track with the melody line being played to assist in learning the song, as well as a midi accompaniment track. When recording your audition, please record yourself using the accompaniment track.
