





A Note from the Director and Daywright ...

More than a year ago, I was approached by my friend Dan Clark and asked to write an adaptation of A Christmas Carol for his theater group, Britches & Hose. He told me that he had admired my writing in other plays, particularly my style and touches of humor. Flattered, I agreed to the task., and set about rereading Dickens' original story. Soon I completed the play, and then watched as Dan, as director, and his talented cast and crew brought my writing to the stage.

This year that same play comes to the Sterling Playmakers. As you watch, you may hear some long-lost dialogue that I had discovered in the pages of the novel, as well as some new twists on well-known lines. My purpose in adapting this story was not to change A Christmas Carol but to give it a fresh yet familiar feeling, to honor the author and to respect the expectations of the audience. I hope that this version takes you back to the first time you were transported to Victorian London, allowing you to once again enjoy the warmth, the humor, the tears, and the joy of Charles Dickens' most popular work.
